AudioFAX IP LLC was established to license and administrate its telecommunications patents. The company was created as a spin-off from **AudioFAX**, Inc., an Atlanta-based company founded in 1987, which is credited with pioneering many of the technologies now used in the enhanced fax industry. **AudioFAX** initiated a patent licensing program in early 1997 with the help of intellectual property consulting firm InteCap and the law firms of Powell, Goldstein, Frazer & Murphy LLP (**AudioFAX's** licensing and litigation counsel) and Womble, Carlyle, Sandridge & Rice (**AudioFAX's** patent counsel).

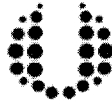
